Written by speech and language therapists these five two-hour sessions will enable you to maximise the communication skills of the adults and young people with profound and multiple learning difficulties with whom you live and work.

The course workbook is full of strategies and activities that can be used in all environments, at home, and at school.

The aims are

- To share information about communication particularly in relation to children with severe and complex needs.
- To learn about the challenges children and young people with multiple learning needs have with communication.
- To explore ideas to help you communicate with your child or young person.
- To meet other parents and carers and share ideas.

Topics covered

- Understanding what's happening when we talk to each other.
- Developing thinking and play skills.
- Maximising interaction
- Using objects, pictures, signs and symbols to communicate.
- Encouraging children to communicate with us.
